Withdrawal of the NI Accreditation of DP Training Solution LLC, USA and instruction to NI approved			
training centres			
We inform all our training providers that the Nautical Institute has withdrawn its accreditation of DP Training Solution, LLC, of 1 Linden Place, Suite 312, Great Neck, NY 11021, USA, with effect from 13th April 2022, due to non-compliance with The Nautical Institute training standards.			
Training centres that receive candidates with an Induction Course certificate from DP Training Solution, LLC for the Simulator course should note that additional actions are required.			
Specifically, candidates who have completed their Induction Course at DP Training Solution, LLC <u>must</u> take and pass the online TestReach Induction exam before being eligible for the Simulator course.			
Centres accepting candidates under these circumstances are responsible for ensuring this action is taken for all enrolments from 20 th April 2022.			
If the candidate fails the Induction Course online exam, they must repeat the Induction Course before commencing the Simulator Course. Candidates may be allowed one re-sit opportunity only.			
The candidate's sea time and task sections in the logbook will not be affected.			
All fees should be borne by the candidates for the online exam and Induction Course if they need to repeat the course. The candidate can contact DP Training Solution for any refund as per their agreement if they wish to.			
Candidates from DP Training Solution LLC, who have successfully completed their simulator course prior to 20 th April 2022 are not affected by this requirement and should complete their sea service and applications in the usual way.
