Removal of COVID-19 Temporary Training Arrangements for Induction Course			
<p>The Nautical Institute had temporarily authorised DP Induction course online course delivery during the COVID-19 Pandemic, valid until 30th September 2022, with the approval of the DPTEG Committee.</p> <p>The DPTEG and the NI recognised that the COVID-19 restrictions have been relaxed in most parts of the world and it is now possible for face-to-face training and travel. The NI will not extend the temporary online Induction Course authorisation beyond 30th September 2022 and from this date all Induction Courses must be delivered by face to face training in the NI approved Training Centres.</p> <p>The training providers wishing to offer online induction courses permanently may apply to the NI for approval per the Nautical Institute Accreditation and Certification Standards Volume 1 and Annex A.</p> <p>Applications should be submitted in writing (e-mail) to the Head of Qualifications Marine & Offshore Qasim.masood@nautinst.org / accreditations@nautinst.org</p>
