DPVM Minimum Entry Requirements			
The Nautical Institute witnessed that a few countries do not have specific qualifications for electricians or ETOs, and they are issued with Rating CoCs, STCW III/7, and are considered on a case-by-case basis. The DPTEG, in its 36 th Session on 16 th May 2024, reached a collective decision that the minimum entry qualification is to be accepted with STCW regulation III/7. This decision was made with the aim of maintaining industry standards and ensuring the best practices are followed. The NI will update the minimum entry requirements in the 2025 standards.
