TRANSFERRING FROM OLD TO NEW SCHEME			
The Nautical Institute has allow	ved DPO's to transfer f	rom the Old scheme	to the New scheme

The Nautical Institute has allowed DPO's to transfer from the Old scheme to the New scheme since 2015 and will continue to do so for the foreseeable future.

The current procedure for doing this was laid out in circular <u>001/2015</u>, where the candidate would need to surrender their original logbook to the NI along with a letter requesting that they be transferred onto the New Scheme. A new grey logbook would be issued to them, with the inclusion of their personal details and induction course information being entered into the logbook for them.

It has come to our attention that most candidates wanting to do this, are first approaching training centres to repeat the Induction Course and asking to be issued with a New Scheme logbook instead of having the course details added into their original NI logbook. In order to avoid any delay to the candidate being able to start the training, they may now surrender their original NI DP logbook to the training centre for disposal, who will then issue them with the New Scheme logbook on successful completion of the Induction course.

If the candidate has already opened an application on their account for the Old Scheme, they will need to send an email to the Qualifications Team at <u>dp@nautinst.org</u>, informing us that they have transferred to the New Scheme, and will need to attach a copy of the personal details page of the new logbook so that the logbook number can be added to their account, and a New Scheme application opened for them.

Please note that as stated in the circular above, any sea time that has been previously gained by the candidate cannot be transferred to the New Scheme.
